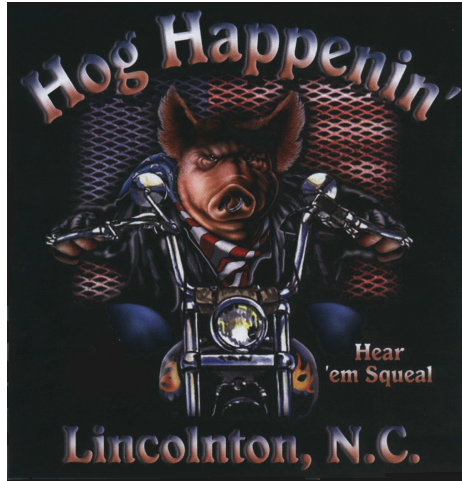

2011 LINCOLNTON HOG HAPPENIN' PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

"POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS" FOOD VENDORS

1. Festival hours are Friday, June 3, 2011, 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. and Saturday, June 4, 2011, 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. "Potentially hazardous" (i.e., meat) food vendors must be set up in the food court (James W. Warren Citizens Center parking lot) **no later than 12:00 Noon, Friday, June 3, 2011**. They may set up at any time between 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 Noon, Friday, June 3, 2011. Breakdown will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 3, 2011 and must be completed by 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 4, 2011. No cars will be allowed into the festival area before 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 4, 2011.
2. Entry Fees (include one 20' x 20' space):

Applications received January 7, 2011 – April 22, 2011	\$100
Applications received April 25, 2011 – May 13, 2011	\$125
Applications received After May 13, 2011	\$150
3. In addition to the Hog Happenin' application and entry fee, the State of North Carolina requires that temporary food vendors also complete a Temporary Food Vendor application and pay a \$75 inspection fee to the local environmental health agency. Application forms are available at www.HogHappenin.org/foodvendors.html. For more information, call Lincoln County Environmental Health at (704) 736-8426.
4. Electricity is **not** available. If you need electricity, please plan to bring a generator.
5. A description of your booth setup is required on the vendor application. Please include the tongues of any trailers to be used in your vending area in the dimensions that you give. Please note that if you plan to use a trailer in your vending space, the trailer, *including the tongue*, must fit in the space that you purchased. If you will be vending from a trailer, please also include which side of the trailer your vending window is on.
6. Special requests for locations can not be guaranteed and are based on availability and layout.
7. Restroom facilities will be located throughout the event.
8. In accordance with city ordinance, only pets who are participating in the event are allowed at Hog Happenin'. A pet's degree of participation in the event is at the discretion of the Lincolnton Police Department.
9. We reserve the right to deny any application. If your application is not accepted, your application fees will be refunded.
10. All vendors are responsible for providing their own equipment.
11. Refunds will not be given to vendors who cancel their registration after Friday, May 20, 2011.
12. **Food stand inspections will be conducted beginning at 12:00 Noon, Friday, June 3, 2011.** Your food stand must meet all criteria set forth by Lincoln County Environmental Health to pass inspection and to be allowed to vend at the event. If your food stand does not pass inspection and you are not allowed to vend, your vending fee will not be refunded.
13. The streets of downtown Lincolnton will remain closed throughout the event. Vendors may wish to leave their booths up overnight on June 3, 2011. In doing so, vendor acknowledges that Hog Happenin', the Downtown Development Association of Lincolnton, The City of Lincolnton, Lincoln County, nor any partnering agencies will be held responsible for damage to or loss of goods.
14. **The Hog Happenin' will go on rain or shine**; however, if public safety officials dictate cancellation of the event due to severe weather, neither Hog Happenin', The Downtown Development Association of Lincolnton, The City of Lincolnton, Lincoln County, nor any partnering agencies will be bound to reschedule the event, nor will the aforementioned entities be bound to reimburse vendor fees.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY: In consideration of your accepting this entry, I the undersigned, intending to be legally bound, hereby, for myself, my heirs, executors, and administrators, waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages I may have against the Hog Happenin' Barbeque Cook-off organizers, Lincoln County, City of Lincolnton, the Downtown Development Association of Lincolnton, their representatives, successors, and assign for any and all injuries suffered by me. Further, I hereby grant full permission to Hog Happenin', and/or agents authorized by them, to any photographs, videotapes, recordings or any other record of this event for any legitimate purpose. All state and local alcohol laws enforced.
